She will also represent the organization on councils, in the media, on boards, and participate in selected task forces and workgroups.

She also steered the organization's work assisting communities recovering from COVID-19, hurricanes and other natural disasters. She was a primary contributing author of IEDC publications on topics including disaster recovery, strategic planning, workforce development and renewable energy.

Clogston has worked in economic consulting firms in Montgomery County and Silicon Valley where she focused on affordable housing, workforce development and economic development projects locally, nationally and internationally.

Clogston has also worked as a journalist covering policy and politics for local, national and international news outlets. Additionally, she has taught political science courses at Johns Hopkins University and the University of Maryland Baltimore County and Labor Economics at the University of Richmond.

She holds a doctoral degree in political science and a master's degree in applied economics from Johns Hopkins University and a bachelor's degree with a double major in urban studies and economics from Stanford University.
