Board Chair Beverly called the meeting to order at 8:36 am. A quorum of the Directors was present. Ms. Magwood was designated to take the minutes.

Consent Agenda

Mr. Beverly presented the Consent Agenda consisting of the minutes from the October 19, 2022, meeting. Ms. Fine moved to approve the minutes as presented. Ms. Hsin seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Annual Board Planning Calendar

Mr. Beverly engaged the Board in a discussion about the Board's priorities and proposed action items for the remainder of the fiscal year. Mr. Beverly asked the Board to comment on the planning which includes specific topics for review and discussion. The Board suggested that time be added to the calendar to continue previous discussion around permitting and barriers that prevent businesses from getting started and growing in the county.

Business Development Report

Mr. Stewart introduced and welcomed the new hire Narbeli Galindo, Business Community Engagement Manager, Diversity & Inclusion. Ms. Galindo greeted the Board and provided a summary of her economic development and international experience.

Mr. Stewart announced that a project that has evolved over an 18-month period, known locally as BioReliance Corporation, MilliporeSigma, the U.S. and Canada Life Science business of Merck KGaA, Darmstadt, Germany, is growing its presence in Montgomery County with a \$286 million investment to expand its biosafety testing capacity. BioReliance currently has five locations in Rockville and has signed a lease to build a new 250,000-square-foot facility at the Traville Gateway campus It is being developed and operated by Alexandria Real Estate Equities, Inc. BioReliance currently has 600 employees now and intend to add 500 more employees in that facility.

Fund Development Committee Report

Dr. Kumar reported that the Fund Development Committee met to discuss the Committee's responsibilities and plans for future fundraising. The Committee requested that MCEDC staff:

- Identify three key initiatives for funding and the value propositions for each
- Develop a prospect list of potential funders to include foundations, businesses and federal agencies
- Research what economic development organizations in the region are doing as far as Board member give or get policies

Treasurer's Report

Ms. Hsin presented the financial statements for the period ending October 31, 2022. Ms. Hsin noted that cash at the end of the period totaled \$835k. An outstanding receivable from Montgomery County Government in the amount of \$1.6M has since been received. Ms. Hsin discussed budget variances and noted which ones were permanent or temporary. Ms. Hsin noted that the format of the financial statement will be revised to provide the Board with comparative information from the previous fiscal year.

President & CEO Report

Mr. Beverly noted that Mr. Tompkins could not attend the Board meeting due to his participation in the Maryland SisterStates delegation in South Africa. Mr. Tompkins is joining 20 county and state officials, and members of universities, colleges, and the private business sector. This relationship has existed since 2014 and MCEDC is participating for the first time. The delegation will focus on economic development, trade, tourism and educational opportunities within the South African region of Kwa/Zulu-Natal which encompasses Durban, Johannesburg and Cape Town

Ms. Fine commended Mr. Tompkins on the business lunch meetings he is hosting and asked that Mr. Tompkins share feedback from those meeting in upcoming President's reports.

New Business

Ms. Larsen announced the upcoming Minority Legislative Breakfast on December 8 from 7:30-10:00 am at Bethesda North Marriott Hotel & Conference Center. More information is available at https://mlbmd.org/.

Closed Session
